### **Milestone for Carnegie**

Shares in Carnegie lifted yesterday after the company successfully launched a new prototype of CETO buoy off the coast of Fremantle. ETO technology promises to convert wave energy to zero-emission electricity and purified drinking water. The deployment moves Carnegie one step closer to its goal of commercialising clean-energy and clean-water buoys by 2009. Carnegie is vying with US-based Ocean Power Technologies to provide wave-generated power for the desalination plant being planned at Binningup. The CETO buoy was attached to a pre-deployed mooring in seven meters deep water so the company can investigate the volume and pressure limits of the unit.
